1. Counsel for the petitioner while restricting his arguments submits that petitioner will be satisfied if respondent No.2 deposes some senior gazetted police officer to consider and decide representation Annexure P-2 dated 07.03.2025 given by the petitioner, in accordance with law, at the earliest. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that DSP, Payal who is recently transferred from there was compelling the petitioner to enter into compromise with private respondents No.4 to 9 and as the petitioner refused to do so, the said police officer also threatened to cause physical harm to the petitioner.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. J.S. Dhaliwal, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State and submits that representation Annexure P-2 given by the petitioner is still pending, as the petitioner is not responding to the notice issued to him to appear before the competent authority in regard to his



representation. The State counsel further submits that in case, the petitioner appears before the concerned authority within a period of next one week, his representation Annexure P-2 will be disposed of within a period of next 7 days thereof, in accordance with law.

4. In view of above and without going into the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to depute a senior gazetted police officer who should consider and decide representation dated 07.03.2025 (Annexure P-2) in accordance with law within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order, subject to prompt appearance of the petitioner before the said authority, at the earliest. The said Senior gazetted police officer is also to assess threat perception if any is there and to submit its report in this regard to respondent No.2 who is to take necessary steps in accordance with law if the situation so warrants.
