JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent to act upon Deployment Offer Letter dated 05.05.2023 (Annexure P-2).
2. The respondent No.3 i.e. Haryana Kaushal Rozgar Nigam Ltd. is a limited company incorporated by State Government with intent to act as an outsource manpower agency. The petitioner through aforesaid agency participated in the trial conducted by Haryana Police Force for the post of Driver. The respondent No.3 while recommending name of many candidates recommended name of petitioner, however, Superintendent of Police, Fatehabad has refused to take him on roll.
3. Ms. Rajni Gupta, Addl. A.G., Haryana submits that respondent No.3 cannot compel any organization to engage a person recommended by them. The Police force has rejected candidature of petitioner, however, his name has not been deleted from the portal and respondent No.3 would endeavour to deploy him in any other organization.
4. In the wake of statement of learned State counsel, the present petition stands disposed of.
