1. In deference to the directions issued by the co-ordinate Bench of this Court, vide order dated 10.01.2025, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the cost of Rs.5,000/-, as imposed upon him, has already been deposited with the Social Welfare Fund Committee of Bar Clerks Association, Punjab and Haryana High Court, Chandigarh, and he has also placed on record the photocopy of the receipt thereof, today in the Court. The same is taken on the record.

2. Through the instant petition, a prayer is made for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to conduct the inquiry against the petitioner, in accordance with the provisions of Section 17-A of the Prevention of Corruption (Amendment) Act, 2018, and strictly adhere to the mandate of the *ibid* Act.
