The instant revision petition, preferred under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, prays for the issuance of a direction to the Court of Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Bhiwani to decide the application under Order 1 Rule 10 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 (for short the "CPC") filed by the petitioner on 16.02.2023.

2. On the last date of hearing, after having heard learned counsel for the petitioner, the following order was passed:-

"Before proceeding further, let a report be called from the District & Sessions Judge, Bhiwani as to what orders are being awaited by the trial Court in Civil Suit No.65 of 2023, dated 12.01.2023, titled as Madan Lal Sharma v. Dakshin Haryana Bijli Vitran Nigam and others, and whether there is any stay of proceedings.

Adjourned to 09.09.2025."

3. A report has been received from the District & Sessions Judge, Bhiwani, in which, it has been submitted that it had inadvertently been recorded by the trial Court while adjourning the case that orders from the Appellate Court were awaited whereas, no matter was pending before the Appellate Court. It has also been submitted by the presiding officer



concerned that he would decide the application under Order 1 Rule 10 CPC, which is pending for 24.09.2025, expeditiously, in accordance with law.

5. That being so, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.

6. The revision petition is accordingly disposed of.
