The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner(s) in case bearing FIR No.17 dated 12.02.2025, under Section(s) 109, 115 (2), 126 (2), 351 (2), 191 (3) and 190 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (Sections 117 (2) of BNS, 2023 added later on) registered at Police Station City-I, Sangrur, District Sangrur.

2 Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the order dated 16.07.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner(s) has joined investigation and is no longer required for investigation of the case.

3 Learned State counsel, on instruction from SI Ranjit Singh,

corroborates the said averment and submits that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner(s) is not required for the purpose of investigation.

4 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

5 Since the petitioner(s) has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 16.07.2025 is made absolute.

6 However, the petitioner(s) shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
