SUVIR SEHGAL, J.(ORAL)

1. Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India *inter alia* for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents to take action on representations dated 04.03.2024 and 04.10.2024, Annexures P-7 and P-8, respectively.

2. Counsel for the petitioners contends that Sukhbir Singh was working as an Assistant Manager with Kaithal District Primary Cooperative Agricultural and Rural Development Bank and he died in a road accident on 07.10.2023. By making a reference to instructions, Annexure P-5, she states



that deceased was entitled to an insurance cover of Rs.30 lacs, which has not been paid to the petitioners, who are his widow and minor children. She submits that petitioners have given various representations, but they are not being looked into. She has requested that a direction be issued to the respondent concerned to examine the representation.

3. Having heard counsel for the petitioners and noticing the limited prayer made by her, this Court does not intend to call upon the respondents.

4. As representations are pending, a direction is issued to respondent No.5 to examine representation dated 04.03.2024, Annexure P-7, and decide it by giving reasons, within a period of three months from the date of communication of a copy of this order.

5. Writ petition is disposed of.
