[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 20.08.2019, in CWP No.21837 of 2019 in case titled as '**Rajbir and others versus Union of India and others**'.

[2] At the outset, learned counsel or the petitioners states that claim of the petitioners as contained in legal notice dated 25.02.2019 has been decided by the respondent by passing speaking order dated 27.07.2022 and that in the circumstances, the petitioners are not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to challenge order dated 27.07.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[3] Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.1/UOI states that he has no objection to the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners.

[4] Accordingly, in the light of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioners as prayed for.
