Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.283 dated 19.11.2024 registered under Sections 115, 126, 190, 191(3), 351(3), 110 of BNS, 2023 at Police Station Sahlwas, District Jhajjar.

2. On the last date of hearing, it transpired that petitioner No.1 was not physically present at the time of the main occurrence while petitioner No.2 who was present at the spot was empty handed at the time of the main occurrence and resultantly, the petitioners were granted interim bail with direction to join investigation with the police.

3. Today, counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners brought to the notice of this Court that in compliance of earlier order, the petitioners have joined investigation with the police.

4. State counsel on instructions from SI Rajesh Kumar apprised the Court that subsequently offences under Section 109 and 117(2) of BNS are added against the accused persons including the present petitioners.

5. State counsel further made statement that the petitioners who have already joined investigation are no longer required for purpose of further investigation by the police in this case.

6. In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 12.12.2024 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.
