2025 under Section 483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of regular bail in FIR No. 0078 dated 18.11.2024 (Annexure P-1), under Section 108, 3(5) of BNS 2023, registered at Police Station Division 1, District Pathankot. These petitions have arisen out of same FIR, therefore, these petitions are taken up together for disposal.

2. Learned counsel representing State has filed status report in CRM-M-31708-2025.
