**YASHVIR SINGH RATHOR, J. (Oral)**

1.                Prayer in this petition filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya  
Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 is for quashing of F.I.R. No.78 dated  
18.06.2018 registered under Sections 323, 324, 341, 34 of IPC at Police  
Station Kathgarh, District SBS Nagar along with all subsequent  
proceedings arising therefrom including the judgment of conviction and  
order of sentence dated 13.11.2024 (Annexure P-2), on the basis of  
compromise dated 02.04.2025 (Annexure P-3).

2.                This Court vide order dated 25.07.2025 had directed the  
parties to appear before the Trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate to get their  
statements recorded and the learned Magistrate was directed to send



his/her report qua the genuineness of the compromise.

3. Pursuant to the aforesaid order, parties have appeared before learned Chief Judicial Magistrate and got their statements recorded. On the basis of the statements so recorded, learned Magistrate has submitted report dated 20.08.2025 to the effect that the compromise has been effected between the parties voluntarily and without any coercion or undue influence.

4. Learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for respondent No.2 have not disputed the factum of compromise between the parties.

5. In view of the above, no useful purpose would be served to continue with the proceedings before the trial Court in the instant F.I.R. following the principles laid down by this Court in *2013 (4) RCR (Criminal) 102* titled as '*Sube Singh and another versus State of Haryana and another*' and the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Criminal Appeal No.1393 of 2011, LL 2021 SC 589 titled as '*Ramawtar Versus State of Madhya Pradesh*' decided on 25.10.2021, this petition is allowed and judgment and order of sentence dated 13.11.2024 (Annexure P-2) passed by ld. Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Balachaur and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise qua petitioners, are hereby quashed.

6. Pending misc. application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
