Prayer made in present writ petition is for grant of 2nd and 3rd
ACP alleging that the action of the authorities in not granting the same is
illegal and arbitrary as well as in violation of Article 14 of the Constitution
of India.

2 Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this juncture
the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent
No.3-Divisional Forest Officer, Rewari, Forest Division, Rewari, to decide
the representation dated 01.07.2024 (Annexure P-4) followed by subsequent
reminders dated 30.07.2024 and 02.09.2024 (Annexures P-5 and P-6)

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submitted by him by passing a speaking and reasoned order in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.

3 Notice of motion.

4 Mr. Tapan Kumar, DAG, Haryana, enters appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that he has no objection to the aforesaid prayer being granted.

5 Accordingly, with the consent of the parties and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Divisional Forest Officer, Rewari, Forest Division, Rewari, to decide the representation dated 01.07.2024 (Annexure P-4) followed by subsequent reminders dated 30.07.2024 and 02.09.2024 (Annexures P-5 and P-6) submitted by the petitioner and to pass a speaking and reasoned order thereupon in accordance with law within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order after granting an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, if prescribed under law.

6 Needless to mention that in the event the entitlement of the petitioner being established as per law, the payment due to the petitioner shall be released expeditiously and preferably within a further period of two months.
