The appellants/plaintiffs have filed the present appeal against the concurrent findings of the learned Courts below whereby the suit filed by the appellants/plaintiffs for declaration and permanent injunction has been dismissed.

The matter pertains to the year 2019 and is still notice of motion has not been issued in the matter. The order sheets shows that as many as five times i.e.28.9.2023, 21.11.2023, 28.2.2024, 08.08.2024 and 05.2.2025 the matter has been listed for hearing, however, from the very inception neither the learned arguing counsel for the appellants nor the proxy counsel on behalf of appellants have put in appearance. Even today there is no representation on behalf of appellants.

A bare reading of the above facts shows that the appellants have exhibited an utterly casual attitude in the pursuit of



the present litigation. It is to be appreciated that very valuable public time of the Court has been expended in affording opportunities to the appellants in the interest of justice. On the other hand, the appellants have adopted an utterly casual and careless approach. It is clear that neither the appellants nor their counsel are seriously interested in pursuing the present matter. Thus, this Court is left with no other option except to **dismiss** the same for non-prosecution.

Ordered accordingly.
