1. Petitioner 'B' filed petition under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 4 to take action against respondents No. 5 to 9 as per law, since FIR No.28 dated 22.02.2025 (Annexure P-2) has been registered under Section 64 of BNS 2023 at Police Station Division No.6, Police Commissionerate Jalandhar but no concrete action has been taken thereunder.

2. Learned counsel representing State has filed status report regarding the status of FIR No.28 dated 22.02.2025 (Annexure P-2), which is taken on record. It is pointed out that after proper investigation cancellation report has been submitted before the learned Area Magistrate on 30.06.2025. Petitioner has an efficacious remedy available to her to file a protest petition. Relief sought by the petitioner is not permissible under the law. Special investigation team was constituted by Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar and thorough investigation

was carried out and considering all aspects of the case, cancellation report was filed.

3. Today, learned counsel representing state further referred to the order dated 05.07.2025 passed by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jalandhar vide which cancellation report was not accepted and it was returned back for further investigation.

4. In the light of aforesaid factual position, it is evident that learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jalandhar has already directed the investigating agency to further investigate the matter in controversy and cancellation report has been returned. Therefore, no further direction is required in this matter, the petition stands disposed of accordingly.

5. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
