1. In the present petition, the grievance being raised by the petitioner is that the petitioner is working in an industry, which manufactures Asbestos and certain occupational health hazards were encountered with while performing the duties, which needs to be taken care of by the respondent No.2 by directing respondent No.3 to take care of such occupational health hazard.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance in the representation dated 28.02.2025 (Annexure P-7), which is still pending consideration with the respondent No.3 and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a direction is issued to the respondent No.3 to decide the same by passing an appropriate

speaking order in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Gaurav Jindal, Addl. A.G. Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, representation is received by the respondent No.2, the same will be decided by the respondent No.2 by passing an appropriate speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of such representation. In case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons for not accepting the claim of the petitioner will be mentioned in the speaking order so passed which order will be conveyed to the petitioners for his information and necessary action.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to raise the issue by way of representation to respondent No.2
