1. This petition has been filed under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023, seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.127 dated 18.06.2025, registered under Sections 115(1), 118(1), 3(5), 126(2), 351(2) of BNS, 2023, at Police Station Kartarpur, District Jalandhar (Rural).

2. On 11.07.2025, the following order was passed:-

4. In view of the statement of learned State counsel, order dated 11.07.2025 is hereby made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the terms and conditions envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS (*erstwhile Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973*).

5. The petition stands disposed of.
