The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure seeking quashing of FIR No.207 dated 09.11.2013 (Annexure P-1) registered under Section 509 of IPC, 1860 at Police Station Sector 3 North, Chandigarh and quashing of Chargesheet dated 21.12.2013 (Annexure P-2) and all other subsequent proceedings arising thereof.
