1. The instant petition has been filed for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondents for willfully disobeying the directions passed by this Court vide order dated 26.11.2024 (Annexure P-5), passed in CWP-31570-2024.

2. Reply filed by way of affidavit of Charumita, Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Moga-respondent No.3 is taken on record and para No.4 of the aforesaid affidavit reads as under:-

“4. That it is submitted that the Respondent No.3 is not the member of the above said Committee. However, the committee has now granted approval for payment. Now resolution has been passed by the Municipal Corporation Moga in the House Meeting dated 21.07.2025 for payment of Rs.5 Lakhs to the petitioner. In view of the above, the payment has been made vide cheque no.334579 dated 01-08-2025.”

5. In view of the aforementioned submissions made in the affidavit filed on behalf of respondent No.3, present petition stands



disposed of. However, the petitioner shall have the right to file an application for revival of this petition, in case of any misrepresentation in the reply.

6. Rule stands discharged.

7. Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of.
