The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India *inter alia* seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing order dated 03.11.2009 (Annexure P-1) passed by learned Assistant Collector 1st Grade, Gurgaon, order dated 09.10.2014 (Annexure P-3) passed by learned Commissioner, Gurgaon Division, Gurgaon and order dated 07.01.2025 (Annexure P-4) passed by learned Financial Commissioner, Haryana.
