1. In the present petition, the petitioners are praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to fix their pay at par with their juniors after removing the pay anomaly, which has arisen upon revision of pay scales with effect from 01.01.2016.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners, on instructions from the petitioners, submits that at this stage, he will be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.4 to decide legal notice dated 10.04.2025 (Annexure P-9), in a time bound manner.

In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 10.04.2025 (Annexure P-9), within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law. In case, the petitioners are found to be entitled to the relief as claimed in the legal notice, the same be released within a period of 04 weeks thereafter.
