1. Petitioner has approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, seeking direction to official respondents to take action against the private respondents, who have illegally occupied the petitioner's land.

2. After addressing for some time, counsel for the petitioner seeks and is granted permission to withdraw the writ petition with liberty to take recourse to the remedies available to the petitioner in accordance with law.
