1. The contempt petition has been filed for deliberate and intentional disobedience of order dated 18.10.2022 passed in CWP-24065-2022.
2. On the last date of hearing i.e. 15.09.2025, since there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner, registry was directed to issue notice to the petitioners as well as to their counsel for the date fixed and it was made clear that if on the next date of hearing, the case is not argued, then appropriate orders shall follow.
3. Today, as per the report of registry, notices issued to petitioner No.1, 2, 4 & 5 not received back served. Notice issued to petitioner No.3 has been served through Whatsapp and notice issued to petitioner No.6 received back unserved. However, learned counsel for the petitioners has been informed regarding date fixed through e-mail.



4. However, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioners despite service.

5. Hence, this Court is left with no choice but to dismiss the present contempt petition for want of prosecution.

6. Dismissed for non-prosecution.
