1. The petitioners have filed by present petition alleging willful violation of the order dated 24.11.2023 (Annexure P-1) passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CWP-26482-2023 titled as 'Gulshan Kumar Vs. State of Haryana and others'.

Vide order dated 24.11.2023 passed in CWP-26482-2023 it has been directed as following:-

*"The present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 i.e. Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Panipat to decide the legal notice dated 22.06.2023 (Annexure P-7) served upon him by the petitioner in accordance*

*with law within a period of four weeks from today.”*

Learned counsel for respondent No.3 points out that compliance report by way of an affidavit of Dr. Jainder Singh Chillar, IAS, Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Panipat has been filed in which it has been pointed out that a speaking order dated 21.10.2024 in compliance of the order of Writ Court (Annexure R-2) has been filed.
