This is a petition under Section 11(6) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 for the appointment of an arbitrator.

2. The petitioner invoked the arbitration clause. The respondent, has, however, to date not nominated an arbitrator which it is entitled to do under the arbitration clause. The respondent, however, states that its Managing Director has not received any letter. Despite the same, the respondent has no objection to the appointment of an independent arbitrator.

3. The petition is, therefore, disposed of by appointing Mr. B.R. Bansal, a retired Additional Sessions Judge, as the sole arbitrator.

4. The fees shall be as per the Chandigarh Arbitration Centre (CAC) (Administrative Cost and Arbitrators' Fees) Rules, 2014.
