Counsel for the petitioners is not in position to dispute that the execution *qua* the order passed by the Rent Controller, was filed. However, the same was withdrawn by suffering statement that the execution stands satisfied. He, however, submits that still part of the premises has not been vacated.

2. Counsel prays for withdrawn of the instant contempt petition with liberty to seek revival of the execution petition.

3. In view of above, the instant contempt petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for, if so permissible under the law.
