1. The present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been filed by the petitioners, for quashing of General Diary Number 005 dated 28.04.2023 qua the petitioner in FIR No. 117 dated 26.04.2023, dated 05.06.2022 (Annexure P-1), for the offences punishable under Sections 307, 365, 452, 379(2), 148, 149 and 506 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act 1860, registered at Police Station Police Commissionerate Amritsar and all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 25.11.2023 (Annexure P-2).

2. Learned State counsel informs that there are total eight accused in the FIR and out them only one has filed the present petition and three accused have been declared as proclaimed offenders

3. Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to file a fresh comprehensive petition by impleading all the necessary parties.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as sought and recorded hereabove.
