1. The petitioner prays for grant of regular bail during the pendency of criminal case arising out of FIR No. 144 dated 15.04.2025 registered under Sections 115, 118(1), 109, 3(5) and 351(1) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS) 2023, Police Station City Kharar, SAS Nagar (Mohali).

2. At the outset, it is noticed that the first informant and the petitioners have entered into a settlement and the petitioner has already suffered incarceration for a period of nearly 02 months.

3. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Pavitter Pal Singh submits that final report is being prepared. It is evident that the investigation is complete. Further incarceration of the petitioner shall not be appropriate.



4. Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the aforesaid facts, it is considered appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate.

5. The petition stands allowed.
