1. The appellant herein is the husband of the respondent. The Principal Judge, Family Court, Ludhiana, has assessed interim maintenance at the rate of Rs.40,000/- per month, keeping in view the fact that the appellant's family runs multiple businesses including Deep Educational Society, Deep Finance Corporation. The appellant is also a partner in Associated Global Services, an immigration firm.



2. The respondent-wife has alleged that the appellant's family maintains as many as six cars, including two Mercedes.
3. Learned counsel representing the appellant submits that his family is maintaining only one Mercedes car, which is of 2007 Model.
4. The Principal Judge, Family Court, Ludhiana, has considered all aspects of the matter while assessing the amount of interim maintenance.
5. Hence, no ground to interfere is made out.
6. Dismissed.
7. Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
