This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned action of the respondents, whereby the petitioners have been relieved/terminated without passing any formal order and despite the fact that vacancies are still available with the respondents. The availability of such vacancies is evident from letter dated 13.05.2025 (Annexure P-8) issued by respondent No.4 to respondent No.2 and letter dated 11.04.2025 (Annexure P-9) issued by respondent No.3 to respondent No.5.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has drawn attention to letter dated 11.04.2025 (Annexure P-9), wherein the Deputy Director, Animal Husbandry and Dairying Department, Hisar, communicated to the Managing Director, Haryana Pashudhan Vikas Board, Panchkula, that 154 posts of Sweeper-cum-Chowkidar were lying

vacant. This supports the claim of the petitioners, who also rely upon the Government instructions dated 07.08.2024 and 15.01.2025 (Annexures P-6 and P-7) issued by the Human Resource Department, Government of Haryana. As per the said instructions, all Administrative Secretaries and Heads of Departments were authorized to make recruitment, and in cases where HKRNL or outsourced employees were removed due to the joining of newly recruited common cadre Group-D employees, the concerned Head of Department was empowered to accommodate them against other suitable vacant posts.

Accordingly, the Deputy Director, Animal Husbandry and Dairying Department, Hisar, as well as the Managing Director, Haryana Pashudhan Vikas Board, Panchkula, are directed to consider the case of the petitioners in the light of the aforesaid policy/instructions against 154 posts stated to be lying vacant, as is evident from letter dated 11.04.2025 (Annexure P-9). In case any formalities or requisitions are required, the Managing Director, Haryana Pashudhan Vikas Board, Panchkula shall necessitate requisitions to the HKRNL and pursue the matter accordingly. Upon receipt of such requisition, the HKRNL shall do the needful qua the recommendation of petitioners within one week thereafter.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to submit a representation before the Managing Director, Haryana Pashudhan Vikas Board, Panchkula, for redressal of their grievance.

Ordered accordingly.
