**HARKESH MANUJA, J. (Oral)**

1. By way of present petition filed under Sections 10 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, proceedings are sought to be initiated against the respondents on account of alleged willful violation of order dated 21.06.2023 passed by the Writ Court in CWP No.13657 of 2023, whereby both the parties were directed to maintain *status quo*.

2. In response, an affidavit dated 30.08.2024 of Sh. Manav Malik, Estate Officer, HSVP, Panchkula has already been filed in the Registry of this Court, the same is taken on record. Perusal of the said affidavit shows that no demolition is being carried out pertaining to the constructions raised by the petitioners as it was only the constructions which were raised post interim order dated 21.06.2023 passed by the Writ Court were erased.

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent Nos.2 to 4 also assures that the existing constructions which are subject matter of status quo shall not be altered/demolished till the final outcome of the writ petition.

4. In such circumstances, no cause survives in the present petition. The same is disposed of. Rule stands discharged.
