1. Prayer made in the present petition is for directing the respondents to grant the benefit of leave encashment for 450 days to the petitioners in lieu of unutilized the same lying at their credit on the dates of their superannuation, rather than payment of 300 said leaves (paid to them), alongwith arrears of pay and consequential benefits.

2. Learned counsel would contend that regarding the claim raised in the present petition, a legal notice dated 06.09.2024, Annexure P-4, has been served upon the respondents, which has yet not evoked any response. He, on instructions, prays that a direction may be given to the respondents to decide the same in a time bound manner, to which learned State counsel has no objection.

3. In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to

the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 06.09.2024, Annexure P-4, within a period of 6 months, which this Court has no reason to believe the authorities would not address in a just, fair and reasonable manner. Upon doing so, after notice and hearing offered to them and if found entitled, grant the benefit forthwith. Needless to say, if the orders are adverse to their interest, the same shall contain reasons and the petitioners shall be free to seek legal redress thereupon.
