1. The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking quashing of FIR No.188 dated 17.09.2024 registered under Sections 75 & 79 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 at Police Station Sector 31, Chandigarh and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

2. On receipt of advance copy of the petition, Mr. Sandeep Vashisht, Addl. P.P. for U.T. Chandigarh has put in appearance and on instructions, submits that the offence in the present case was committed by the petitioner in public and in view of the law laid down by this court in *CRM-M-25919-2025 titled as 'Krish and others Vs. State of Punjab and another' decided on 13.05.2025*, the instant petition is not maintainable. He further submits that apart from respondent No.2, there were two other complainants namely Sheetal Negi daughter of S.S. Negi and Jasbir, who are neither party in the compromise nor have been impleaded in the present petition.
