The matter has been taken up through video conferencing on account of lockdown due to outbreak of COVID-19 pandemic.

The petitioner Anil Kumar has filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer to initiate contempt proceedings against the respondent for willful disobedience and non-compliance of the order dated 12.12.2019.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that on perusal of the order dated 12.12.2019 would show that the writ petition was disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the claim as made in the legal notice dated 04.10.2019 (P3).

Records show that on 11.06.2020, notice of motion was issued.

Learned State counsel submits that the Director, Elementary Education, Haryana has passed the order dated 16.06.2020 and the same has been endorsed to District Elementary Education Officer, Charkhi Dadri on 18.06.2020. The petitioner has given his address as Charkhi Dadri and therefore the office of District Elementary Education Officer, Charkhi Dadri was required to serve the same upon the petitioner.

On the asking of the Court, the said order has been forwarded to counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner may be given liberty to challenge such portion of the order which the petitioner wishes to challenge.

The contempt petition is accordingly disposed of with liberty as prayed for.
