



The petitioner in each of these petitions is different. The agreements in each of the cases are similar except as to the quantum of the claim. The petitioners in each of the cases had entered into different agreements with respondent No.1. The other respondents are not proper or necessary parties as they are not parties to the arbitration agreement. This order is, therefore, confined to respondent No.1.

The contract contains an arbitration clause. Disputes and differences have arisen between the parties.

The petitions are, therefore, disposed of only between the petitioners and respondent No.1 by appointing Shri C.B. Jagli an, former District Judge, Haryana, as the sole Arbitrator in each of the cases.

It is clarified that though the Arbitrator is common, the references shall be separate and separate awards shall be passed. The fee of the Arbitrator shall be as per the Chandigarh Arbitration Centre (CAC) (Administrative Cost and Arbitrators' Fees) Rules, 2014. The venue for the arbitration will be Gurgaon.
