1. In the present appeal, the challenge raised is to the order dated 24.02.2011 passed by the learned District Judge, Family Court, Faridabad, on a petition filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, with regard to the restitution of the conjugal rights.
2.
