1. Present contempt petition has been filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act for punishing the respondent for intentional and willful disobedience of the judgment/order dated 26.02.2024 passed by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court.

2. Learned counsel appearing for the respondent has submitted that the grievance of the petitioner in the present case is with respect to domestic electricity supply. It is further submitted that the domestic electricity supply is being provided to the members of the petitioner's society and thus, there is due compliance of the order dated 26.02.2024 by

the respondent.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the above, the present contempt petition be disposed of, but has prayed that the respondent be bound by the above-said statement made before this Court. It is further submitted that in case said statement is found to be incorrect, then, liberty be granted to the petitioner to revive the same.

4. Keeping in view the above-said facts and circumstances, the present contempt petition is disposed of, at this stage. The respondent would be bound by the statement made before this Court. It would be open to the petitioner to move an application for revival of the present contempt petition in case the said statement is found to be incorrect.
