1. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that vide speaking order dated 04.03.2025 passed by the District Education Officer (S.E.), Gurdaspur, the claim of the petitioners has been accepted and the necessary payment shall be released to them within 06 weeks from today.
2. In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition, as such, the same is disposed of. Rule stands discharged.

However, in case the needful is not done, as per undertaking, the petitioners would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring /concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioners towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on

the first date of listing of revival application, if any.

4. Pending miscellaneous application, if any, shall also stands disposed of.
