Report from the Mediation & Conciliation Centre has been received. As per the same, settlement has been reached between the parties.

However, as per the settlement, the counsel for the applicant submits that the respondent has not come forward to facilitate filing of the petition u/s 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act. On query, counsel for the respondent submits that he has to firstly withdraw the petition u/s 13 of Hindu Marriage Act, filed at his instance.

In the given circumstances, counsel for respondent gives an undertaking to withdraw the petition u/s 13 of Hindu Marriage Act, filed by the respondent, within a period of two weeks from today onwards, by way of filing of an application before the concerned court and upon withdrawal of the said petition, the respondent along with the applicant shall be filing the

petition u/s 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act, within a period of next seven days thereafter.

In view of the undertaking given aforesaid, counsel for the applicant submits that he does not want to pursue with the transfer application and the same be dismissed as withdrawn.

Ordered accordingly.

However, the parties shall remain bound by the undertaking given by the counsel, as recorded aforesaid.
