HARSH BUNGER J. (ORAL)

Petition herein is, *inter alia*, for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus, directing the official respondents to consider and decide the petitioner's representations dated 23.12.2024 (Annexure P-4), 03.01.2025 (Annexure P-5) and 12.02.2025 (Annexure P-7) in a time bound manner.

1.1 A further prayer has been made for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to take strict action against respondent No.4, in accordance with law, for raising illegal and unauthorized constructions at

Plot No. 20-A, Mianwali Colony, Gurugram, in blatant defiance of the sealing and demolition orders passed by the Municipal Corporation, Gurugram, including repeated acts of illegally breaking the seals.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the outset, submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.3 – Joint Commissioner to Municipal Corporation, Gurugram, to decide representation dated 12.02.2025 (Annexure P-7) submitted by the petitioner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Upasana Dhawan, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana and Mr. Pritam Saini, Advocate, who are present in Court, accept notice on behalf of the respondent-State and respondents No.2 and 3, respectively.

5. Learned counsel for respondents No.2 and 3 submits that representation dated 12.02.2025 (Annexure P-7) submitted by the petitioner shall be considered and finally decided by the Joint Commissioner to Municipal Corporation, Gurugram/competent authority, after affording due opportunity of hearing to all concerned parties, by way of passing a speaking order within a period of two months from today.

6. Keeping in view the aforesaid submissions made by learned counsel for respondents No.2 and 3, the present writ petition is disposed of accordingly.

7. All the pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
