This is a Civil Revision Petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 151 CPC for setting aside the order dated 18.10.2024 (Annexure P-6) passed by the Civil Judge (Jr.Div.), Hisar, vide which the application filed by the petitioners under Order 7 Rule 11 CPC for rejection of the plaint has been dismissed.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the pleas which have been raised in the application under Order 7 Rule 11 CPC have also been raised by the petitioners in their written statement and since in the impugned order it has been mentioned that the grounds taken by the petitioners are disputed question of law and fact and cannot be decided at this stage, thus, the petitioners be permitted to withdraw the present petition at this stage with liberty to raise all the pleas, which have been raised in the written statement and are available to them, during the course of trial.

3. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
