1. In the present petition, the challenge is to the impugned Award dated 21.11.2024 (Annexure P-1), by which, the claim of the petitioner that he is entitled for payment of Rs. 2,02,018/- along with interest @18 % per annum has been declined by the Industrial Tribunal.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner very fairly submits that the similar impugned award dated 21.11.2024 (Annexure P-1) was passed by the Tribunal against one of the other employee namely, Mahesh Pal who had also challenged the said award before this Court by filing of CWP No. 6952 of 2025, titled as '*Mahesh Pal v. Presiding Officer, Industrial Tribunal, Bathinda and others*', which petition has been dismissed by this Court on 12.03.2025 by giving due reasons therein.
3. Keeping in view the fact that, the similar view of the Labour Court has already been upheld by this Court while passing order in *Mahesh Pal's case(supra)* and the facts in the present case and in the *Mahesh Pal's*



case(supra) are also identical, hence, the present petition is also **dismissed** in view of the reasons given in **Mahesh Pal's case (supra)**.

4. Pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, stands disposed of.
