The instant case was filed on 05.03.2024 by Mr. Sardavinder Goyal, Advocate. However, the Registry raised objection on the case file.

As per Rule 9, Chapter 1, Part-A, Volume V, Punjab and Haryana High Court Rules and Orders, the petition on which objections have been raised by the Registry is to be taken back by the counsel/party, who filed it, so as to refile it within a total period of 40 days.
