1. Instant petition has been filed by the petitioner – Company, i.e., M/s Sudhir Forgings Pvt. Ltd., by challenging the order dated 24.01.2024 (Annexure P-1), passed by Ld. JMIC, Ludhiana, whereby, application of the petitioner filed u/s 251 r/w Section 464 Cr.P.C., has been dismissed.

Further, petitioner – Company seeks quashing of complaint i.e., COMA-11120/2017, dated 14.07.2017 – *Rajnesh Oil Company through its Proprietor v. M/s Sudhir Forgings Pvt. Ltd. & others*, filed u/s 138 of the NI Act, 1881 (Annexure P-2). Besides, petitioner – Company also seeks quashing of order dated 14.09.2017 (Annexure P-3), passed by Ld. JMIC, Ludhiana, summoning the petitioner in the aforesaid complaint case.

2. On the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw present petition.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. However, it would be open for the petitioner – Company to take all the pleas, as sought in the present petition, at appropriate stage, in accordance with law, during the course of trial before the Trial Court.
