Learned counsel for applicant/petitioner has filed an application for placing on record compromise-cum-affidavit dated 02.05.2024 (Annexures P-5).

Learned counsel for the State submits that he has no objection to the application being allowed.

For the reasons mentioned in the application and no objection suffered by State counsel, application is allowed and accompanied document (Annexure P-5) is taken on record, subject to just exceptions.

Main case

1. Petitioners have filed instant petition under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No.312 dated 11.07.2020 under Sections 34, 365, 506 of IPC and Section 8 and 18 of POCSO Act registered at Police Station Gharaunda, District Karnal (Annexure P-1) against the petitioners registered at the instance of complainant i.e. respondent No.2 and also all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 19.09.2023 (Annexure P-2).
2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for petitioners, at this stage, submits that he does not want to pursue the present petition seeking quashing of aforesaid FIR and wishes to withdraw the same.
3. In view of the aforesaid statement, present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn.
4. Pending misc. application (s), if any, also stands disposed of.
