1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking cancellation of anticipatory bail in FIR No.117 dated 22.04.2022 under Sections 406/420/506/34 of IPC, 1860 and Sections 10/24 of the Immigration Act, registered at Police Station Pehowa City, Kurukshetra.

2. It has been submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that respondent No.2 after having been granted anticipatory bail by this Court vide order dated 19.05.2023 (Annexure P-2) has left India without seeking permission of the Court. He submits that respondent No.2 has misused the concession of the anticipatory bail and thus, his anticipatory bail deserves to be cancelled.

3. Learned State counsel, however, submits that respondent No.2 has already been declared proclaimed offender on 04.01.2025.

4. Since the respondent has already been declared P.O., no further orders are required to be passed by this Court and the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
