The appellant/plaintiff has challenged the judgment and decree dated 04.3.2022 passed by the Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.) Ludhiana whereby the suit filed by him for permanent injunction restraining the defendant/respondent, its agents, servants, attorneys, assignees, employees, officials, officers, authorities etc. from interfering in the peaceful possession of the plaintiff and dispossessing the plaintiff illegally and forcibly from the suit property has been dismissed; as well as the judgment and decree dated 24.11.2022 passed by the Additional District Judge, Ludhiana whereby the appeal filed by the appellant/plaintiff against the judgment and decree dated 04.3.2022 has also been dismissed.

The matter pertains to the year 2023 and notice is yet to be issued in the same.



Perusal of the order-sheet(s) shows that as many as five times the matter has been adjourned either on request of learned arguing counsel; or learned proxy counsel; or due to non-appearance on behalf of learned counsel for the appellant. Even today there is no representation on behalf of the appellant.

In view of the above, it can safely be presumed that neither the appellant nor his counsel are interested in pursuing the instant appeal. Thus, this Court is left with no other option except to dismiss the same for non-prosecution.

Ordered accordingly.
