The instant applications have been filed under Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 praying for fixing some actual date of hearing in the main petition which was admitted vide order dated 19.11.2024 and also for disposing of the same with a direction to the respondents to decide the claim of the petitioner as espoused in the representation dated 01.06.2020 (Annexure P-4) in a time bound manner in view of the judgment of acquittal

dated 03.03.2025 (Annexure A-1) passed by the District and Sessions Judge, Hisar.

The applications are supported by the affidavit(s) of the petitioner.

Notice in the applications.

Ms. Tanisha Peshawaria, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice in the applications and submits that she has no objection in case the main case is taken on board today itself and is disposed of in terms of the prayer made by the petitioner.

In view of above, the instant applications are allowed and the main case is taken on board today itself for disposal.

Main case

The instant petition had been filed by the petitioner for seeking quashing of the impugned communication/letters dated 21.01.2022 (Annexure P-8) and 25.05.2022 (Annexure P-9) whereby the claim of the petitioner regarding grant of 3rd ACP was kept pending till the decision of the ongoing legal proceedings.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner contends that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the respondent No.2-the Commissioner, Hisar Division, Hisar, to decide the representation dated 01.06.2020 (Annexure P-4) submitted by the petitioner by passing a

speaking and reasoned order in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.

4 Ms. Tanisha Peshawaria, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that she has no objection to the aforesaid prayer being granted.

5 Accordingly, with the consent of the parties and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-the Commissioner, Hisar Division, Hisar, to decide the representation dated 01.06.2020 (Annexure P-4) submitted by the petitioner and also by considering the subsequent development i.e. judgment of acquittal dated 03.03.2025 and to pass a speaking and reasoned order thereupon in accordance with law within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order after granting an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, if prescribed under law.
