1. In the present petition, the petitioners have challenged the order dated 18.06.2020 (Annexure P-6) vide which, the private respondent has been promoted to the post of Revenue Accountant by ignoring the case of the petitioners.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that a legal notice dated 22.04.2024 (Annexure P-7) has been served upon the respondents, however, no decision has been taken thereupon. He further submits, on instructions from the petitioners, that at this stage, he will be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.3 to decide the legal notice dated 22.04.2024 (Annexure P-7) in a time bound manner.
