The matter has again been discussed with the learned counsel for the parties in detail and they have arrived at a settlement.

As agreed, as per statements of the learned counsel for the appellant of the deceased appellant as well as counsel for Insurance Company, separately recorded, a sum of Rs.5,00,000/- over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal, is awarded to the appellant-Ajmer Singh S/o Shri Chattar Singh, in full & final satisfaction of the claim.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a cheque in the sum of Rs.5,00,000/- favoring the appellant-Ajmer Singh S/o Shri Chattar Singh, with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within a period of six weeks from today. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellant's counsel may collect the cheque/draft from the office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the counsel for the appellant.

Pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, stand disposed of.
