In the present petition, the grievance being raised by the petitioner is that she is entitled for certain pensionary benefits as well as service benefits which are not being given despite the fact that the petitioner has already retired on 30.06.2022. The prayer of the petitioner is for the release of all the pensionary benefits. Further prayer of the petitioner is that all the issues raised in the present petition have already been raised in the legal notice dated 28.01.2025 (Annexure P-6) and petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, that the respondents be directed to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. T. P. S. Chawla, Senior DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State and submits that in

case, the legal notice dated 28.01.2025 (Annexure P-6), has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of 08 weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order. Learned counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioner in the speaking order to be passed and the said order will be conveyed to the petitioner for her information and necessary action.

4. Keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents-State, no further order is required to be passed in the present petition and the same is disposed of.

5. However, the State will be bound by the statement recorded hereinabove.

6. Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of accordingly.
