JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent to pay interest on delayed release of provident fund.

2. The petitioner claims that he was dismissed from service on 19.09.2021 whereas provident fund was released on 16.05.2024. Thus, he is entitled to interest for the delayed period.

3. Mr. Raman Sharma, Addl. A.G., Haryana submits that as per applicable Rules, the provident fund withheld by respondent carried interest and payment was made to petitioner alongwith interest. Thus, claim of petitioner is misconceived.

4. Mr. Manav Ahlawat, Advocate appearing on behalf of Mr. Rohit Mittal, Advocate for the petitioner expresses his inability to controvert the aforesaid statement.

5. Disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file an appropriate application if claim of respondent is found incorrect.
